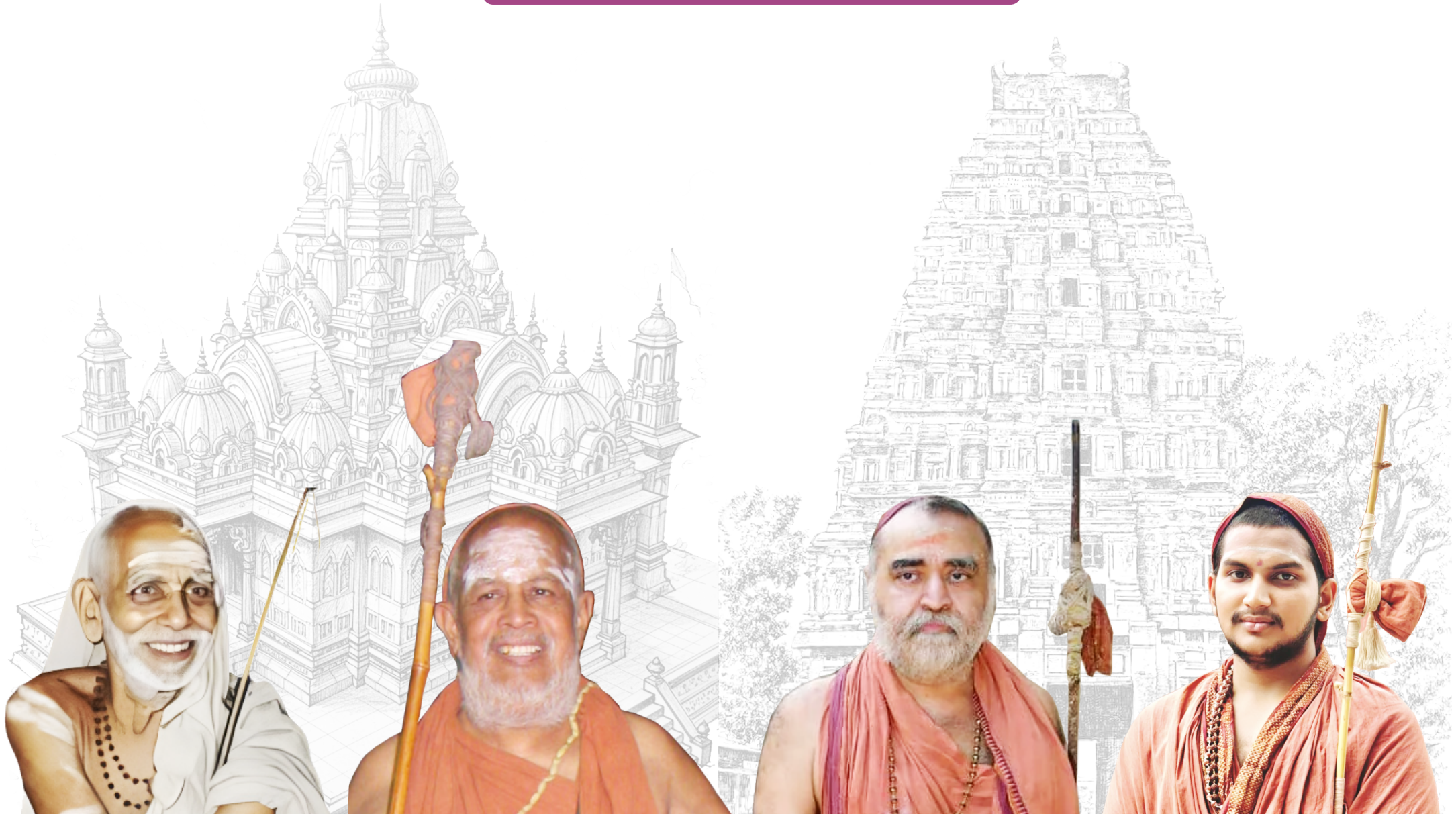

India is a land of many temples and places of worship, both new and centuries old. Some are magnificent architectural wonders with a well-chronicled history and culture of worship and attract a huge influx of devotees while others are calm serene places where one can contemplate and pray in peace. Some temples are magnificent edifices, while a few are open to the sky and the elements with the havoc caused by time, visible on their facades. The Parābhava calendar this year attempts to spotlight some of these temples that lie across the length and breadth of Bharat. All these temples and the hundreds more that we are unable to cover, forge a link to our past and build a bridge to our future.

Lepakshi Temple

The 16th century Vijayanagara style construction, Veerabhadraswamy Temple in Lepakshi near Hindupur in Andhra Pradesh, is associated with the Ramayana. Situated on a hill called the Kurma Saila as it is shaped like a kurma or tortoise, the Temple got its name when Rama, in his search for Sita met the wounded Jatayu there and said 'Lepakshi', which means 'Arise O' bird'. The main deity in the temple is that of Veerabhadra, a fierce form of Shiva. A monolithic Nandi along with a huge sculpture of a seven headed Naga protecting a Lingam, are viewed as icons of Lepakshi. There is a footprint in the temple which is believed to be that of Sita as Ravana stopped here on his way to Lanka after abducting Sita. This footprint always has water in it even in the harshest summer months.

Mundeshwari Temple

Considered to be the oldest temple in India, the Mundeshwari Temple built in 108 CE, is situated on the Kaimur Hill in Bihar and is 100 kms from Varanasi. The Temple, an octagonal stone construction, has a Panchamukha Lingam made from a special stone that changes its colour with the rays of the sun. The Devi here is worshipped as Maa Mundeshwari Devi, depicted as Vaarahi on her Vahana, Mahish. The Temple has the distinction of having had continuous worship since its consecration.

Unakoti

Unakoti, meaning one less than a crore, lies about 8 km from Kailashahar and 170 km from Agartala in the North Eastern State of Tripura. These are magnificent rock carvings of 99,999 Gods, carved on the hillside. It is believed that the Gods and Goddesses used to meet here. Once when they were on a pilgrimage to Kashi along with Shiva, they rested here for a night. However, on the following day, when it was time to leave, all except Shiva were asleep. It is believed that an angry Shiva cursed them and they all turned to stone where they are worshipped till today. The most magnificent of the rock cut image is that of Shiva as 'Unakotiswara KalBhairav'. The Head of Shiva is around 30 feet high. There is Durga standing on a lion, a gigantic Head of Ganesha and Nandi.

Kailasanathar Temple

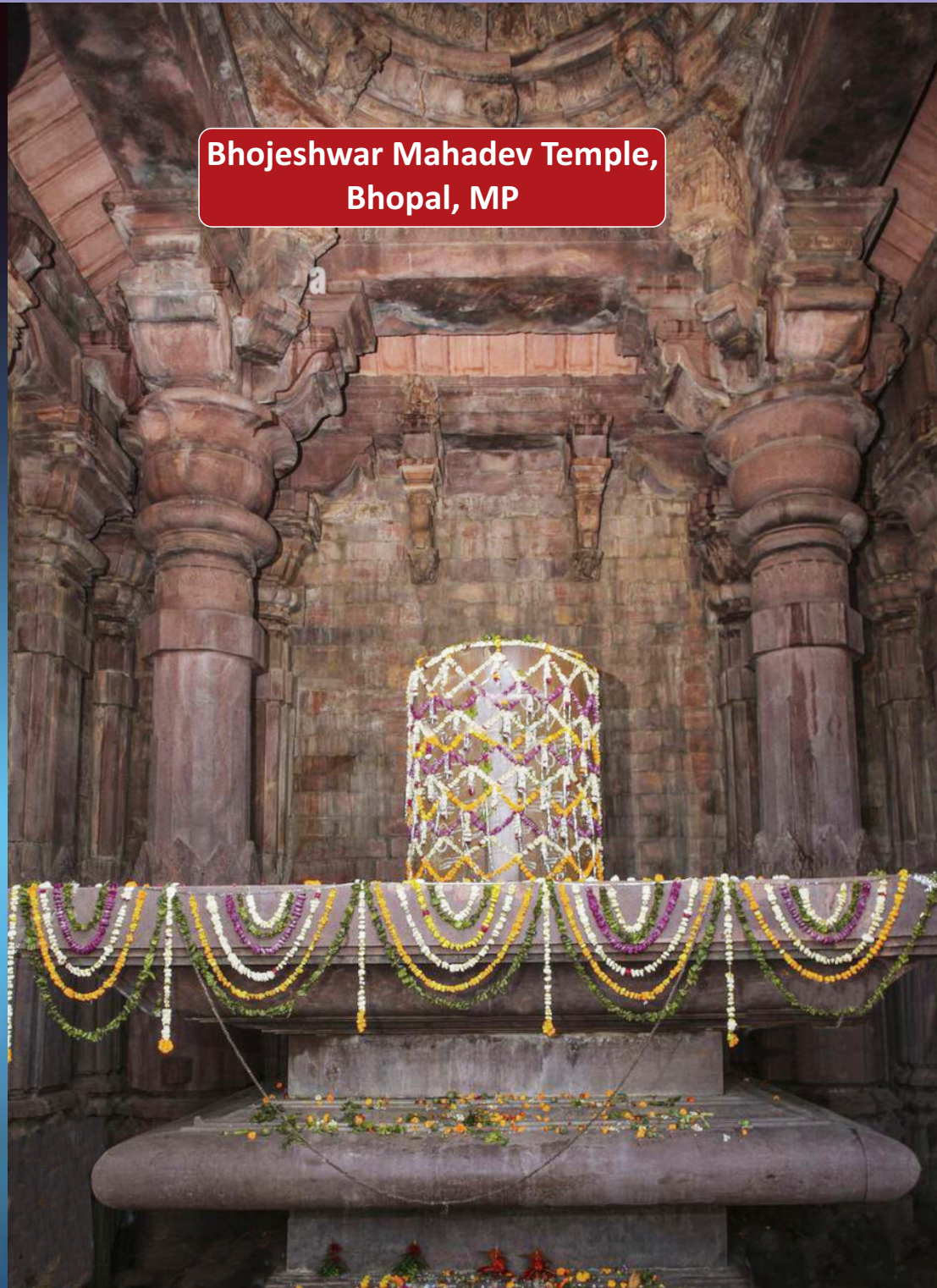
The early 8th Century sandstone temple of Kailasanathar, on the banks of what was once the Vegavathy River in Kanchipuram, TN, is a Pallava architecture. The presiding deity is Shiva as Kailasanathar and the temple is said to resemble Mount Kailash in its shape. The sanctum has a sixteen-sided Shivalingam in black granite. Behind the Lingam, on the wall is a depiction of Shiva as Somaskandar (Shiva-Parvathi-Skanda). The inner sanctum has a circumambulatory narrow passage resembling a chasm. Devotees enter through a narrow opening and circumambulate the passage without looking back. This Pradakshina is said to represent the cycle of birth and death. There are also around 58 smaller sanctums for Shiva. Frescoes (Mural Paintings) once adorned the walls behind these small sanctums, many visible even today.

Ananthasayana Vishnu

Around 8 kms from Talcher in Odisha, on the banks of the River Brahmani, is this 9th Century horizontal sculpture of a sleeping Lord Vishnu. The rock cut sculpture is open to the sky. The Lord is resting with the hood of the Seshanaga covering His head and is wearing a distinctive crown, Kiritamukuta. The sculpture of Vishnu is around 51 ft long and 23 ft wide. He has four arms, and holds the Gadha, Shanka, Chakra and a Lotus. Brahma is sitting in meditation on a lotus that sprouts from the navel of Vishnu. There is no structure of a Temple, but prayers and worship happen here. contd... last page

❖ Ancient & Enduring Sanatana Temples ❖

Neelkant Mahadev Temple

The 11th century Neelkanth Mahadev Temple is located within the Kalinjar Fort in Banda District, UP. It is carved from solid rock into the slope of the mountain and is accessible by descending hundred steps down the hill. The blue stone Ekmukhi Shiva Lingam here is always moist at the throat even today, for it is believed that Shiva came here to quench his thirst after he drank the poison during the churning of the ocean (Samudra Manthan). There are many carvings and rock cut sculptures here including an eighteen armed, 24 feet high Maha Sadasiva. On top of the temple is the Swargahan Kund, which is a natural rock cut body of water.

Bhojeshwar Mahadev Temple

On the banks of the Betwa River near Bhopal in MP, in the town of Bhojpur is the Bhojeshwar Mahadev Temple. Built by Raja Bhoj, this 11th century temple houses a seven and a half feet tall Lingam in its sanctum. The circumference of the Lingam is around eighteen feet and it is made up of three limestone blocks stacked on top of each other. The roof of the temple is rectilinear and is not the traditional curved shikara. Carvings are visible at the entrance of the temple on its walls and ceiling. The architecture of this temple is comparable to the Brihadeesvara Temple in Thanjavur in its grandeur and scale.

Rudreshwara Swamy Temple

The 12th century Rudreshwara Swamy Temple in Hanamakonda in Warangal, Telengana, was built by the Kakatiya King Rudra Deva. It has around a thousand pillars symmetrically laid and so locals call it the Veyisthambala Gudi (temple of thousand pillars). The temple has three presiding deities, Shiva as Rudreshwara, Vishnu as Vasudeva and Surya as Suryadeva. There is also a monolithic Nandi, besides beautiful engravings and sculptures. The base of the temple is star shaped and has seven layers of Pradikshana Pada (circumambulation path) and five layers of kakshasana (a kind of porch).

Ghateshwar Temples

The Ghateshwar temples are a group of nine temples at Batoli in Chittorgarh district, Rajasthan, constructed in the 10th century. It derives its name from the uniquely shaped Ghata or pot shaped Lingam in the Garbagriha. Built in the Nagara architectural style, the sculptures display the artistry of the Pratihara period. Four of the nine temples are dedicated to Shiva, one each to Vishnu, Trimurti and Ganesha and two to Durga as Mahishamardini. The front panel of the Rangamandapam features the Trinity, with Shiva in the centre and Vishnu to His right and Brahma to His left.

Sankaracharya Temple

On a hillock on the Zabarwan Range, next to the Dal Lake in Srinagar, stands the Sankracharya Temple, towering around a thousand feet from the valley and accessed by a series of stairs. The temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva is considered to be the oldest living temple in Kashmir. It is believed that Adi Sankara composed the Soundarya Lahiri here and that is why the temple is associated with and named after Him. Standing on solid rock, the temple has an octagonal shaped basement. The circular Garbagriha houses the Lingam.

Ramalingeshwara Temple

Built around the 10th century by the Nolomba dynasty, the Ramalingeshwara Temple is around 100 kms from Bangalore, in Avani in Kolar district. The temple is dedicated to Rama (Ramalingeshwara) and His brothers, Lakshmana (Lakshmana Lingeshwara), Shatrugna (Shatruganeshwara) and Bharatha (Bharateshwara). Each of the shrines has a Lingam installed. There are small shrines for Vali and Sugreeva and Hanuman. The temple is said to be situated on the site of Valmiki's ashram and the sage composed the Ramayana here. Sita took refuge here after she was banished from Ayodhya and this is the birth place of Lava and Kusha. There is also a Sita Parvathi temple atop a hill from where Sita is said to have returned back to earth.

Ambarnath Shiva Temple

Located on the banks of the River Waldhuni, this 11th century temple stands today in Ambarnath, a suburb of Mumbai. The material used for construction is brown stone, native to the region. The temple was constructed by the rulers of the Shilahar dynasty and incorporates both the Nagara and the Dravidian style of architecture. The Swayambu Lingam is below the ground and is accessible by going down twenty steps. Carvings on the walls include Shiva as Gajantaka, holding the head of the demon Gajasura and a twelve-armed Mahakali holding weapons. There is a sculpture of Brahma on the outer wall and an idol where Shiva, Vishnu, Brahma and Surya are portrayed as a single deity.

Patal Bhuvaneshwar

The Patal Bhuvaneshwar caves, situated about fourteen km from Gangolihat in Pittorgarh district in Uttarakand is said to be as ancient as the earth itself. Mentioned in the Skanda Purana, these caves are the dwelling place of all the Gods and is said to connect through an underground passage, to Mount Kailash. The caves are situated around 500 feet above sea level and are accessible by going down a hundred narrow and rock cut steps. Once below, one is surrounded by various natural formations of stalactites and stalagmites, resembling our Gods. The cave is said to have been from Treta Yuga. Adi Sankaracharya visited the caves on his travels across India. The Pandavas paid homage here on their journey to the Himalayas. The cave has four entrances, the Paapdwaar, Randwaar, Dharamdwaar and Mokshadwaar.
