A Yatra is a spiritual journey and the Yatri is on a spiritual quest. The Yatra is as important as the destination, for the Yatri by concentrating his entire energy on the purpose of his journey, hopes to become enlightened and understand the meaning of life. Unlike today, the Yatris of yore had to undergo tremendous physical stress and suffering during the Yatra, walking for months and years to reach their destination. In the process, they were transformed. Yatras are part of Sanathana Dharma. There are many stories about Rishis walking the length and breadth of Barathavarsha, crossing mountains, rivers and forests in their search for Truth. The **Viśvāvasu** calendar this year, focusses on some of the Yatras that are still undertaken in India today.

Kasi Rameshwaram Yatra

The Kasi Rameshwaram Yatra is undertaken both for enhancing one's spiritual growth and to propitiate the spirits of our ancestors. The Yatra begins from and concludes at Rameshwaram. Bathing in the Agni Tirtham and the 22 wells in the temple of Ramanathaswami is essential before the commencement of the Yatra. The Yatri makes 3 Lingams from the sand here and dissolves 2 of them while carrying the 3rd Lingam, the Veni Lingam to his next stop of the Yatra, the Triveni Sangam in Prayagraj. Here after a holy dip at the Sangam, where the Ganga, Yamuna and the Saraswathi meet, the Yatri dissolves the Lingam and proceeds to Kasi. In Kasi, snanam in the Holy Ganga is followed by a darshan of Lord Vishwanath. Tirtham from the Ganga is then carried by the Yatri to be offered to the Lingam in Rameshwaram.

It is also a common practice for Yatris to perform Shraddham rituals at Kasi followed by Pinda Dhanam at Gaya.

Narmada Parikrama

The Narmada Parikrama is a circumambulation of the River Narmada. The truly devoted Yatris walk along a distance of around 3500 km covering both the banks of the River. The Yatra begins in Amarkantak, the source of the River Narmada and reaches Bharuch where the river meets the Arabian Sea. The Yatris then walk back through the other bank to Amarkantak to complete the Parikrama. Along the route of the Parikrama, the Yatris visit many Khsetra Stanams like Omkareshwar and Maheshwar.

Panch Kedar Yatra

The Panch Kedar Yatra covers five temples of Lord Siva all situated in Uttarakand. Kedarnath is one of the temples and the others are Tungnath, Rudranath, Madhyamaheshwar and Kalpeshwar. These are amongst the highest Siva temples and a visit to them involves a fair amount of trekking. It is believed that the Pandavas went to Varanasi to seek the blessings of Lord Siva. The Lord was however angry with them and disappeared to Uttarakand where the Pandavas found Him grazing as a bull. When they tried to catch the bull, it disappeared into the earth and emerged at 5 different places. The Pandavas established a temple at each of these places, and together they came to be known as Panch Kedar.

Pandharpur Yatra

The Pandharpur Wari as this Yatra is commonly called, is a 21day Yatra by foot from Dehu to Pandharpur or Alandi to Pandharpur, with hundreds of Yatris along the route joining the Yatra. It takes place four times a year but the holiest Wari is the one in the month of Ashad (July) which culminates in Pandharpur on Ashad Ekadasi day. Groups of Yatris carry a palanquin with Padhukas of Sant Tukaram or Dhyaneswar and set out on the Yatra singing devotional songs in praise of Lord Vitobha. The Yatris are called Warkaris or 'one who undertakes the Wari'.

Amarnath Yatra

Amarnath cave in Jammu and Kashmir at an altitude of 12,750 ft, is religiously significant as this is the place where Lord Siva revealed the secret of immortality to Goddess Parvathi. The Amarnath Yatra is usually undertaken in the months of June, July and August when the ice lingam is visible in the cave. The Yatri can start the Yatra from Pahalgam or Baltal. The Pahalgam route covers a distance of 36km. The Baltal route is shorter but is very steep. The opening and closing dates for the Yatra are announced in advance and one needs to register for it. Many Yatris also opt to complete the Yatra in helicopters.

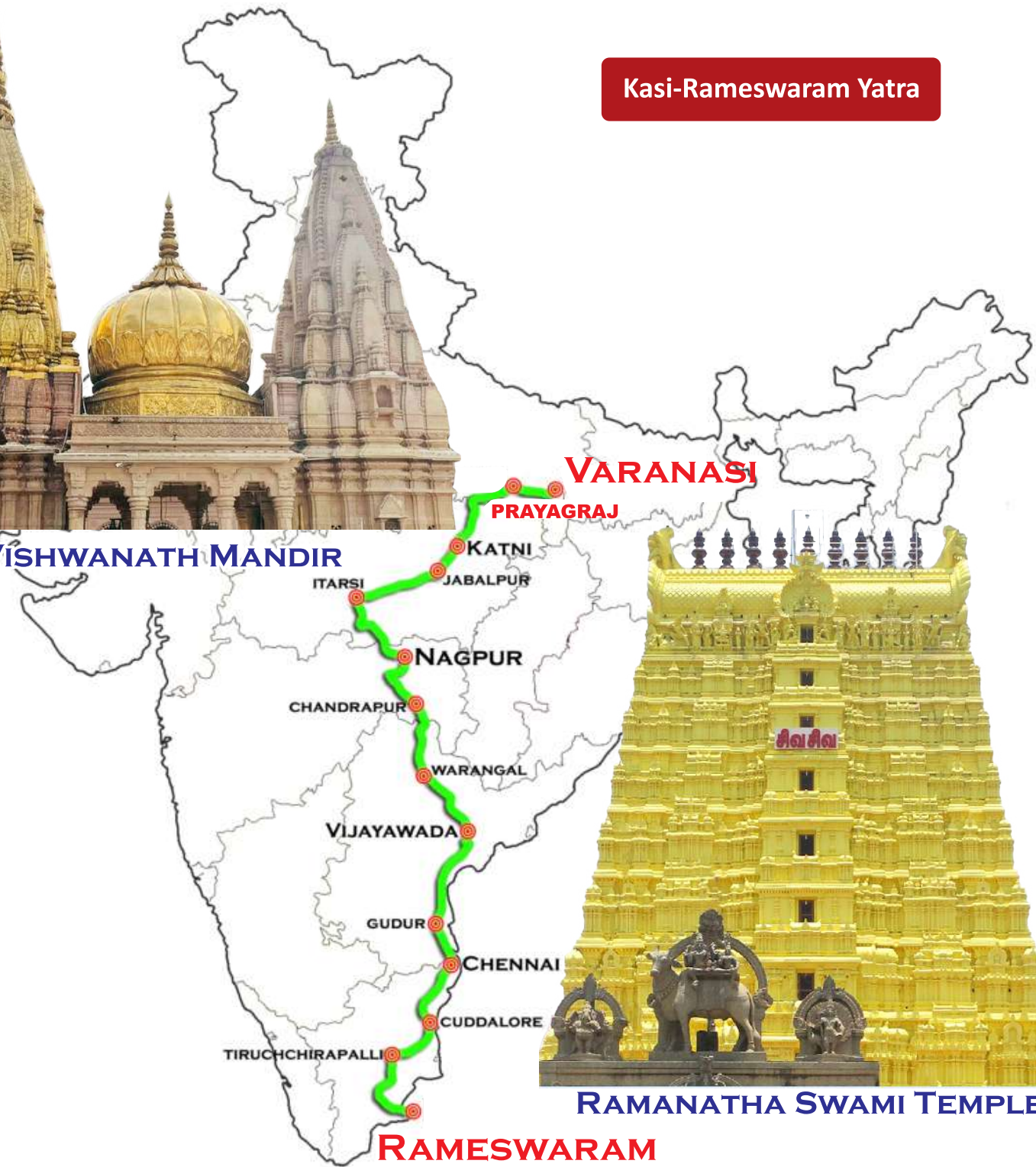
Ashtavinayak Yatra

As the name suggests, Ashta Vinayak Yatra is a Yatra that covers 8 temples of Lord Vinayak and can be completed in 3 days. All the temples are situated in Pune and Raigad districts of Maharashtra. The Murtis are all Swayambhu and the Yatra begins and ends with a Darshan of Moreshwar at Morgaon. The sequence is Moregaon, Siddhatek, Pali, Mahad, Theur, Lenyadri, Ozar and Ranjangaon.

Kasi-Rameswaram Yatra



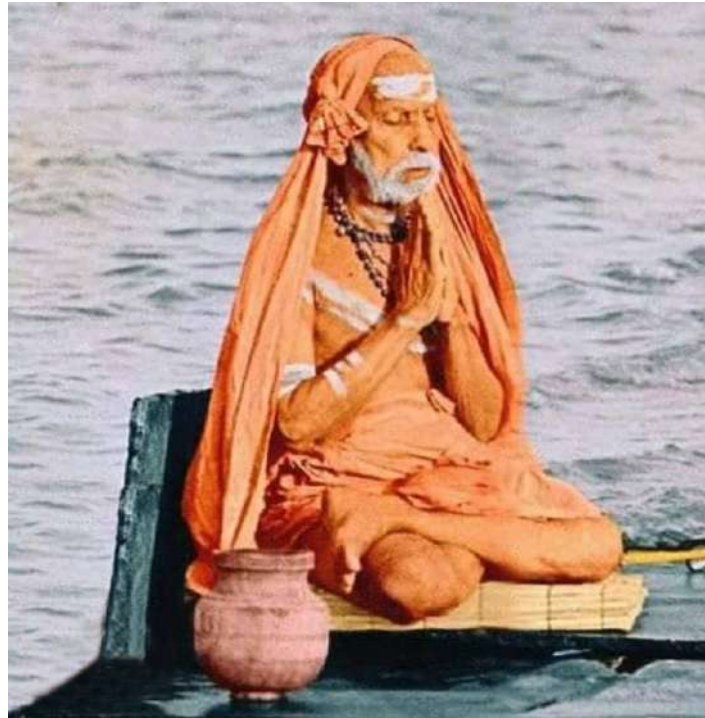

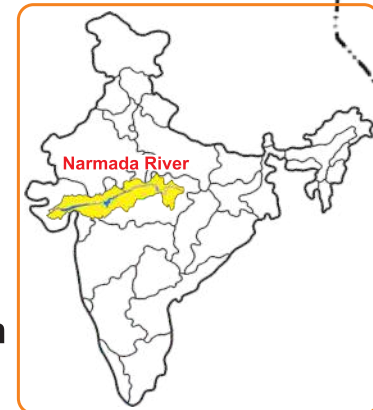

----- Parikrama Route



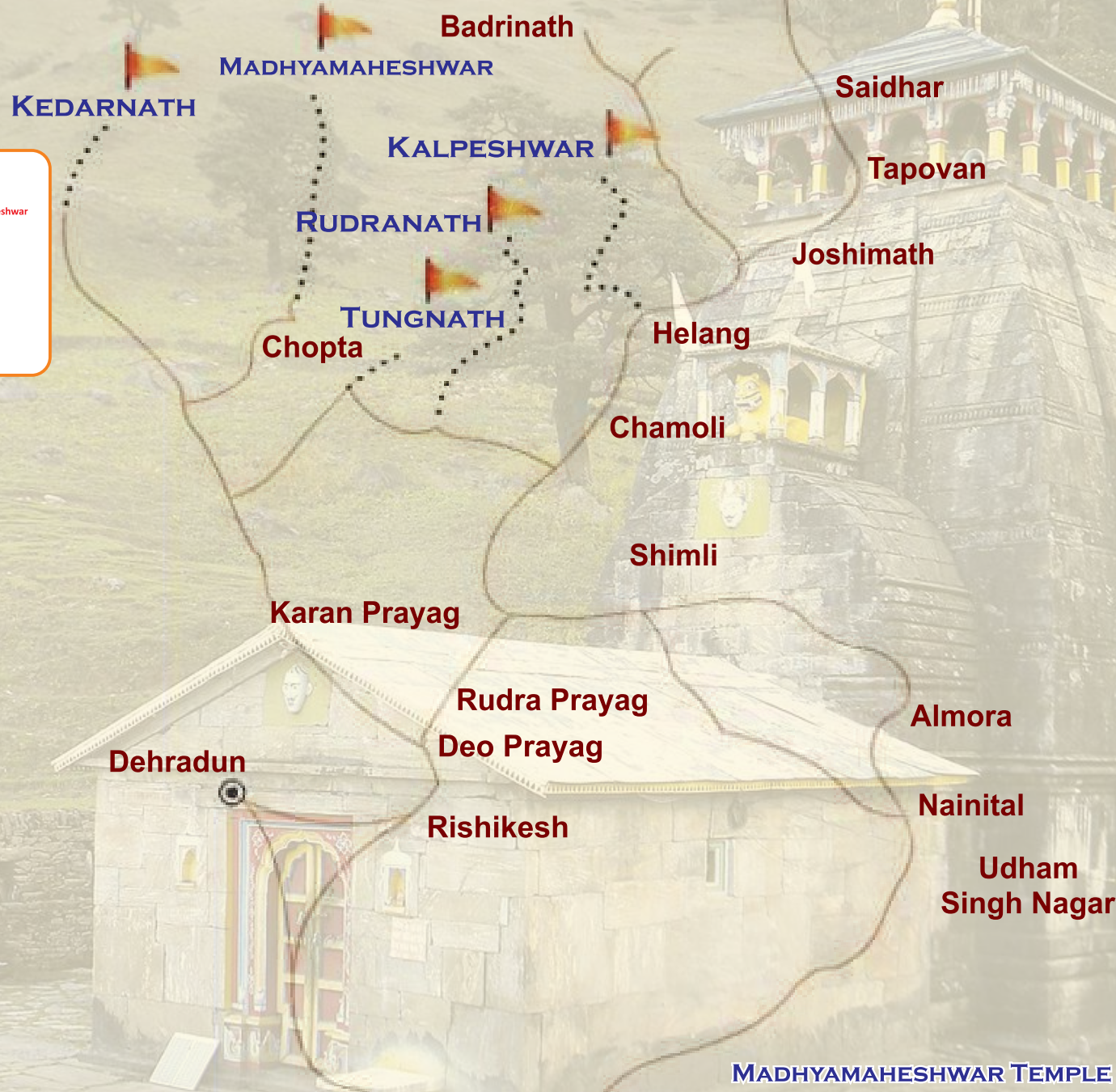

Kailash Manasarovar Yatra

The Kailash Manasarovar Yatra is the holiest of all the Yatras. A Parikrama of Mount Kailash and Lake Manasarovar is both a divine and sublime experience. The 3-day parikrama begins when the Yatri crosses the Yama Dwar about 30km from Darchen. Darchen is in occupied Tibet and can be reached either by crossing the Lipulekh and Nathu La passes from India or crossing the border from Nepal.

The 1st day of the Parikrama involves a trek or a Pony ride of 12 km, from Yama Dwar to Dirapuk. The path meanders through some stunning landscape and increasing altitude. All along the trek, weather permitting, snow covered Mount Kailash can be seen. The Yatris rest for the night at Dirapukh to begin the trek early next day. The distance covered on the 2nd day is around 25Km. There is a steep ascent to cross the Dolma La Pass with an altitude of over 18,000 ft and an equally steep descent. The sacred Gauri Kund can be seen as one descends and Yatris collect water from the sacred Kund.

The Yatris halt for the night at Zutulpuk. The 3rd day of the Parikrama is an easy trek of 6km and buses pick up the Yatris from the end point. Yatris then stay near Lake Manasarovar, bathe in its sacred waters and perform a Havan on its bank.

Govardhan Parikrama

Yatris circumnavigate the sacred mountain of Govardhan near Mathura, to thank Lord Krishna for saving the people of Braj from the anger of Lord Indra, by lifting the mountain with His finger and sheltering His people beneath. This Parikrama takes place the day after Deepavali, when the Yatris literally cook a mountain of food as offering and then walk around the Govardhan mountain. The Parikrama covers a distance of 21km.

Ramayana Trail

The Ramayana Trail has become popular in recent years thanks to the special trains run by the IRCTC covering the places associated with the Ramayana. The 16-day pilgrimage, covers Ayodhya, Janakpur (in Nepal and Sita's birthplace), Triveni Sangam in Prayag, Chitrakoot, Kishkinda (Hampi in Karnataka), Bhadrachalam (site of Dandakaranya Forest) and Rameshwaram. The Yatris also get a chance to visit Varanasi, Nasik besides other sacred places en route. Yatris may continue the Yatra by visiting the places associated with the Ramayana in Sri Lanka.

Girivalam

Girivalam , literally a walk around the mountain, is a 14km Parikrama of the sacred hill of Arunachala in Thiruvannamalai, TN, where the Lord is manifest as the Hill. The Yatra is undertaken on Pournami of each month, with Shivaratri and the month of Karthigai (mid November to mid December) being considered more auspicious. There are Ashta Lingams (8 Lingams) around the circumference of the Hill and the Yatris stop to worship all these Lingams during their circumambulation. While most devotees prefer to walk, one can undertake Girivalam by vehicle also.

Sabarimalai Yatra

Swamiye Saranam Ayyappa ! The devotional chant rings in the air all along the route to Sabarimalai. The number of devotees going on the Yatra is increasing each year. There are 3 routes to Sabarimalai of which the Erumeli route is the longest and the most difficult. This is also the traditional route and the path taken by the Lord Himself when he set out to kill Mahishi. Vandiperiyar and Chalakayam are the other two routes that can be taken to go to the temple. Mid December to Mid January is considered to be the most auspicious time to visit Sabarimalai.

Pancha Kroshi Yatra

The Pancha Kroshi Yatra in Kasi is a circular pilgrimage, beginning and ending at Mani Karnika Ghat. The Yatra covers a distance of 84km, circumambulating the sacred city of Kasi. There are 108 Shiva temples along the route. The Yatra has 5 halts to stop for the night in Dharamshalas established for this purpose. These halts are at Kardameshvara, Bheemchandi, Rameshwar, Shivpur and Kapildhara. It is believed that Lord Rama performed penance in Rameshwar to absolve his father from the sin of killing Sravana. The Pandavas are said to have consecrated 5 lingams in Shivpur and hence the temple is known as the Pancha Linga temple.

Char Dham Yatra

Kedarnath, Badrinath, Gangotri and Yamunotri are amongst the holiest places in Sanathana Dharma. A journey to all the 4 divine sites is the Char Dham Yatra. The Yatra begins from Haridwar and can be undertaken by road. The Yatri visits Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath and then Badrinath. A minimum of 10 days is needed to complete the Yatra, more if one wants to visit other temples and confluences en route. The Yatra can only be undertaken for 6 months of the year, from May to October as the temples remain closed at other times. Helicopter services are also available especially for Kedarnath.
