One of the most important forms of worship is the worship of Mother Goddess who manifests in many forms. Durga, Lakshmi, Saraswati, Kali, Ambal, Amman, Mata, Devi, Thaayaar and more.

She is Divine, loving, ferocious, angry, benign, bounteous, beautiful, the fount of Knowledge, the giver of wealth, the destroyer of evil, the divine consort of Brahma, Vishnu and Siva.

And also, She is a Woman, Wife, Mother, Protector, Slayer and Shakti. She is all these and much more.

The शोभकृत - Shobhakrut - calendar is a humble effort to reinforce some of Her innumerable names, forms and attributes.

'Maan Aap Bulandi', (The Mother Herself Calls), and those who are lucky enough to be called by the Divine Mother, undertake Yatra to the temple of **Vaishno Devi**, a cave in a three peaked mountain called Trikuta near Katra in Jammu. There is a huge rock, immersed in water from which 3 heads known as the Holy Pindies, each of which is distinct from the other, are seen. The Pindies are said to be Mahalakshmi, Maha Kali and Maha Saraswathi who together are said to have taken the form of Vaishno Devi.

Goddess Kali in the Kali Temple at Kalighat in Kolkata, has three eyes, a protruding tongue and four hands, one of which holds a scimitar and another, the head of the demon Shambu. The scimitar signifies Divine Knowledge and the demon head signifies human ego which must be slain by Divine Knowledge in order to attain Moksha. The other two hands are in the abhaya and varada mudras or blessings. According to Puranas, the right toe of Goddess Parvathi fell here when Her body was decapitated by the Sudarshan Chakra.

Annapurna Mata is considered as the queen of Varanasi. 'Anna' (food) and Purna (full), the two fuse in Annapurneshwari Temple in Varanasi. Holding a ladle and a bowl of rice, Annapurneshwari is the Goddess of food and nourishment who gives Her devotees abundance of food and prosperity.

'Maha Amba' or Great Mother, presides over the city of Mumbai as **Mumbadevi**, in the temple of the same name in the heart of the city. The city itself derives its name from the Goddess and the temple. According to legends, Mumbadevi defeated an Asura Mumbarakka, who then begged for forgiveness and went on to worship Her. Mumbadevi is fervently worshipped by the Kolis, the original inhabitants of Mumbai who regard Her as their Protector and Saviour.

Parvathi Devi, in the form of **Akilandeswari** (Mother of the Universe), came to Jambu forest in Thiruvanaikoil in Tamil Nadu and created a Lingam out of water and worshipped Siva. When Siva gave darshan to Her, Akilandeswari took Upadesa (lessons) from Him and learnt the Siva Gnana. In this Temple, Akilandeswari is not worshipped as the Wife of Lord Shiva, but as His student. She is said to have had a ferocious temper. To calm Her down, Sri Adi Shankaracharya adorned the ears of the Goddess with earrings called thaadangam with the Sri Chakra inscribed on them. He also installed a Ganapathy in front of Her to cheer Her up all the time.

Goddess **Chamundeshwari** resides in the Chamundeshwari Temple near Mysore, in Chamundi Hills, that finds a mention in the Skanda Purana. 'Chamundi' or 'Durga' is the fierce form of 'Shakti'. She is the slayer of demons, 'Chanda', 'Munda' and 'Mahishasura', the buffalo-headed monster.

She is the Kula devi of the Mysore Maharajas, the Wodeyars, who have contributed to the grandeur of the temple, including carving 1000 steps to go to the temple.

Ambabai Mahalakshmi of Kolhapur has been sculpted with four arms, wearing a saree in Karnataka style. A stone inscription of 10th century describes the Goddess as Sinhavahini (Goddess astride a lion) and Rudraardhangotsanga Nivasini, (Shiva's consort)." She is considered as second avatar of Durga.

It is believed that Mahalakshmi was once angered by the deference shown by Mahavishnu to Brighu Rishi and She began to do penance in what was then called Karvaripura, now Kolhapur.

The temple celebrates Kirnotsav twice a year, On these days, the rays of the setting sun light up the feet of the Goddess on the first day, Her waist on the second day and illuminate Her face on the third day.

The **Meenakshi Amman** in Madurai, is Parvathi Devi, with a lot of religious significance. The Goddess made from a green stone, is in a standing posture, with a lotus in Her right hand on which is perched a parrot.

The sthala purana has it that the King and Queen of Madurai performed puthra kamesthi yagna. A girl child was born and named "Meenakshi" (eyes being in the shape of fish). She was taught all the 64 Sastras (field of science). During Her coronation, She won over all the three worlds - Satyaloka (Brahma's Abode), Vaikunta (Vishnu's Abode) and Amaravati (Deva's Abode). She also defeated the Bhoothaganas (Guardians) and Nandi (Sacred Bull) of Kailasha, Lord Shiva's abode. There She saw Lord Shiva, and realized that Shiva was Her ordained husband and She is none other than an incarnation of Parvati Devi. The wedding of Meenakshi and Sundareswarar was held in Madurai, with Lord Vishnu presiding over the ceremony. This glorious event is celebrated every year in Madurai as "Chithirai Thiruvizha".

The temple is an architectural grandeur which has 14 multicoloured gopurams and many mandapams including a 1000 pillared one. Many beautiful sculptures are carved in the gopurams and the mandapams.

Goddess **Kamakshi** is seated in padmasana, in the Muktistalam that Kanchipuram is considered to be. She holds a sugar cane bow and floral arrows in Her lower arms and a Pasa (noose) and Ankusa (a sharpened goad with a pointed hook) on Her upper arms. The Ankusa indicates that She is controlling the devotees from going astray and the Pasa indicates that She corrects them from time to time.

As Kamakshi Amman is the presiding deity for the entire town, the processions of all the temples go around the Kamakshi Amman Temple. Adi Sankaracharya Himself installed and consecrated the Sri Chakra inside the sanctum sanctorum. Sri Kamakshi Devi is Raja Rajeswari, and an embodiment of Universal Power- Parasakti. Hence there is no separate Ambal or Shakti shrine in Siva temples within the limits of Kanchipuram.

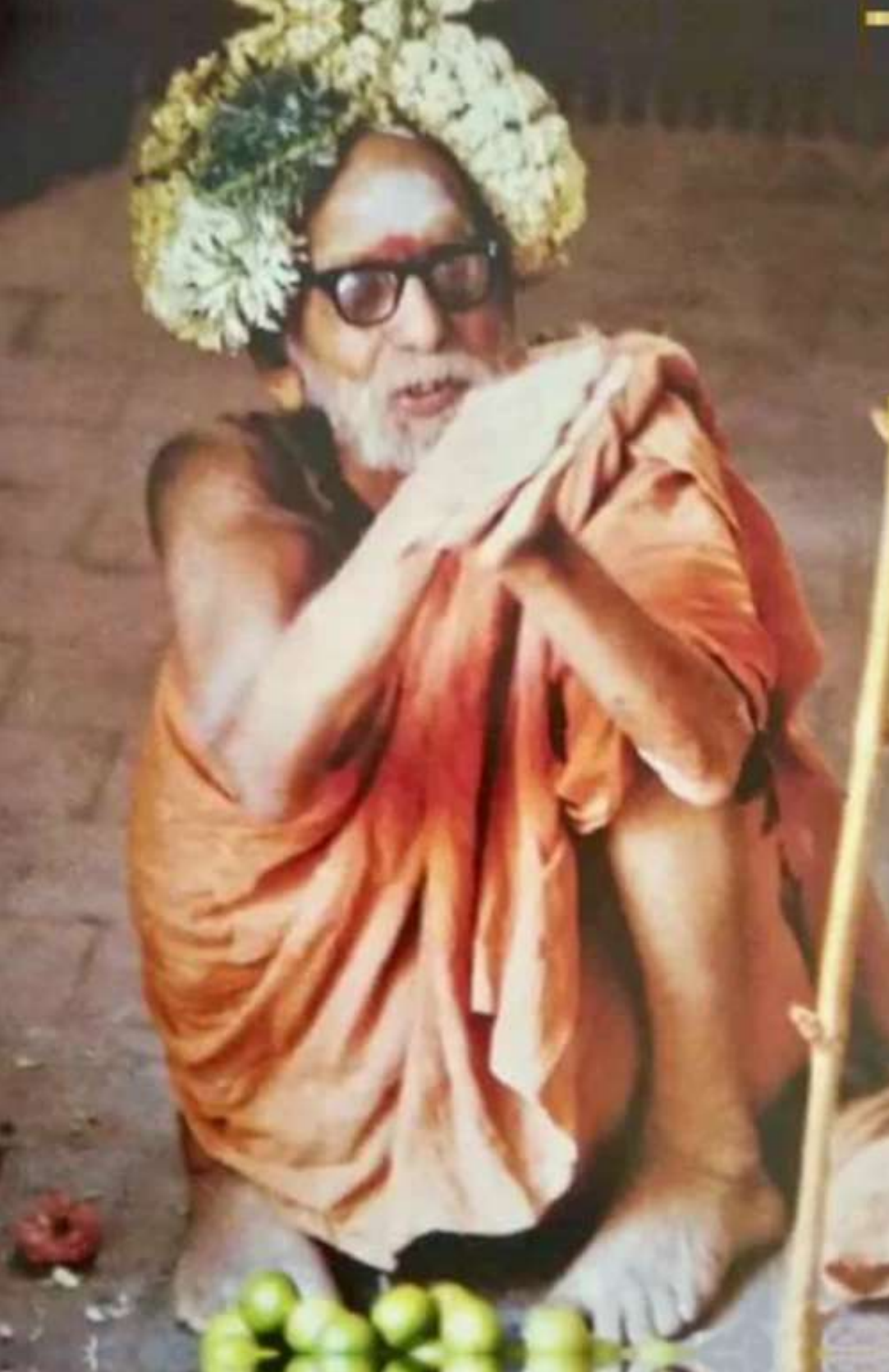
Goddess **Kamakhya** is the yielder of all desires, as per the Kalika Purana, an ancient work in Sanskrit. Kamakhya Temple atop Nilachal Hills near Guwahati in Assam, is the holy place where the Yoni of Goddess Parvathi fell, after Her body was cut into 51 pieces by Vishnu's Sudarshan Chakra. The Garba Gruha here, is accessed through a flight of steps into a cave where the Yoni - a vulva shaped stone moistened by a spring - is worshipped as the Goddess Kamakhya. While there is no image of Shakti in the temple, the object of reverence is the Yoni. The temple is shut for three days every year when the Goddess is said to be menstruating, and the waters of the spring in the Garba Gruha take on a crimson hue at that time.

In Kodungallur, Kerala, Sree **Kurumba Bhagavathi Devi** in Her Temple, represents the goddess in Her fierce form that of Maha Kali or Parashakthi. Facing North, She features eight hands with various attributes- Sword, a Pot (vattaka), a tri-spear (Trishul), khatvanga (a weapon with a skull embedded), the head of demon Darika, a Snake, a bell, another weapon called kheta. The sculpture is about seven feet high and is made from seasoned Jackfruit timber. The structure is adequately protected by yearly "Chandattam" - or bathing with adhesive made of various ingredients.

Bagavathy Devi is said to have emerged here when Shiva opened His third eye when Parasurama was troubled by the demon Daruka.

Kanaka Durga, in Her temple on the banks of the River Krishna in Vijayawada is 8 armed - each hand with Chakra, Conch, Bow & Arrow, Sword, Club, Trident, Thunderbolt and Lotus. She is looking towards north-east, sporting a cool smile, shining eyes with full of bliss. On each day of Navratri festival, the main deity (moola varlu) is decorated in the form of Sri Saraswati, Sri Maha Lakshmi, Sri Bala Tripura Sundari, Sri Rajarajeswari, Sri Mahishasura mardini, Sri Durga devi, Sri Annapurna devi, Sri Gayatri and Sri Lalitha Tripura Sundari.

Visitors to the sacred Tirumala Balaji temple, seek blessings first from His consort, **Padmavati Devi** at Her temple in Tiruchanoor, called Alarmelmangapuram. The Goddess is called Padmavati as She emerged from a lotus when King Akashraja performed yagna to be blessed with a child. Padmavati was brought up with great tenderness until time came for Her to be united with Her celestial Lord, Balaji.

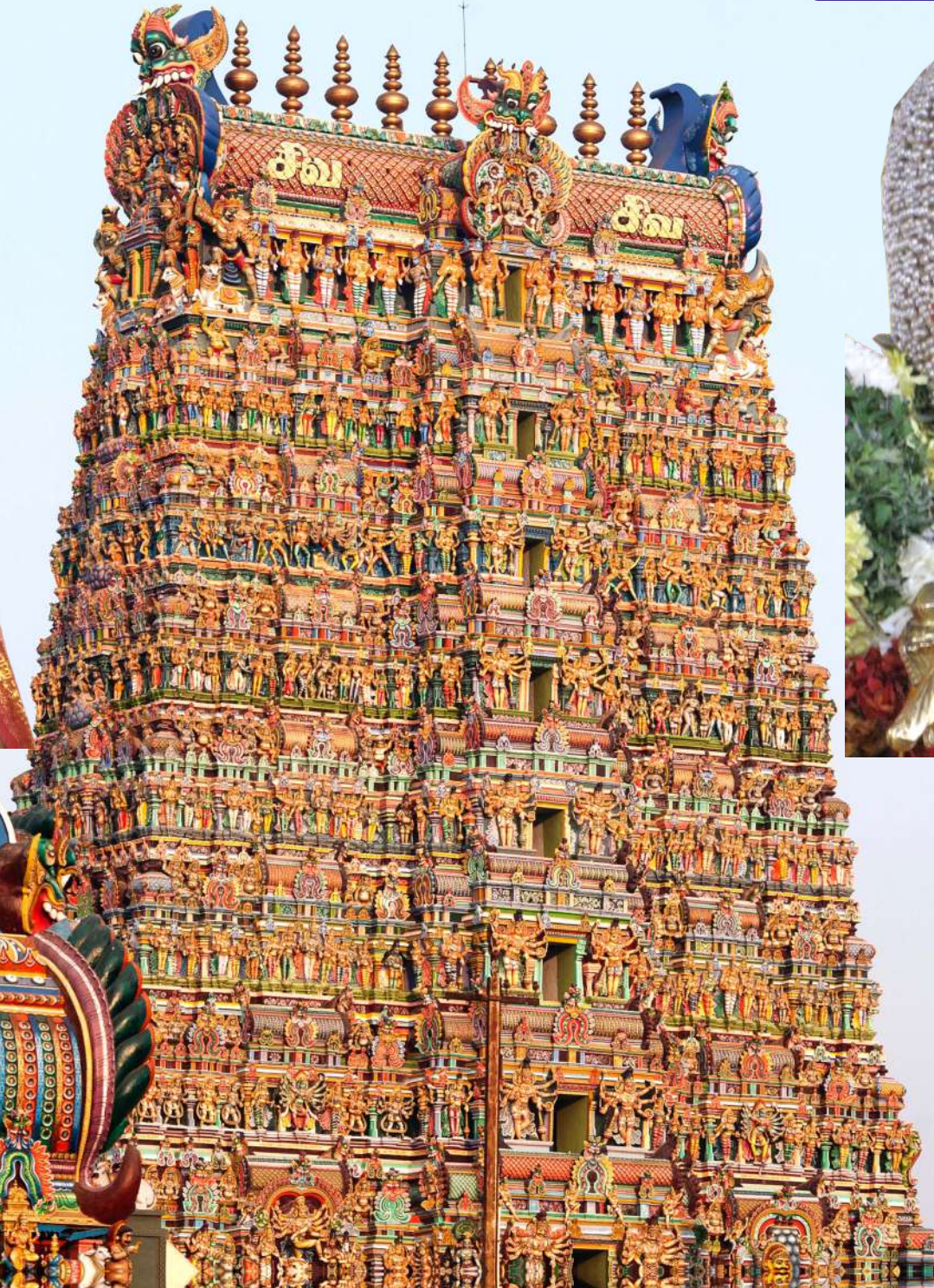

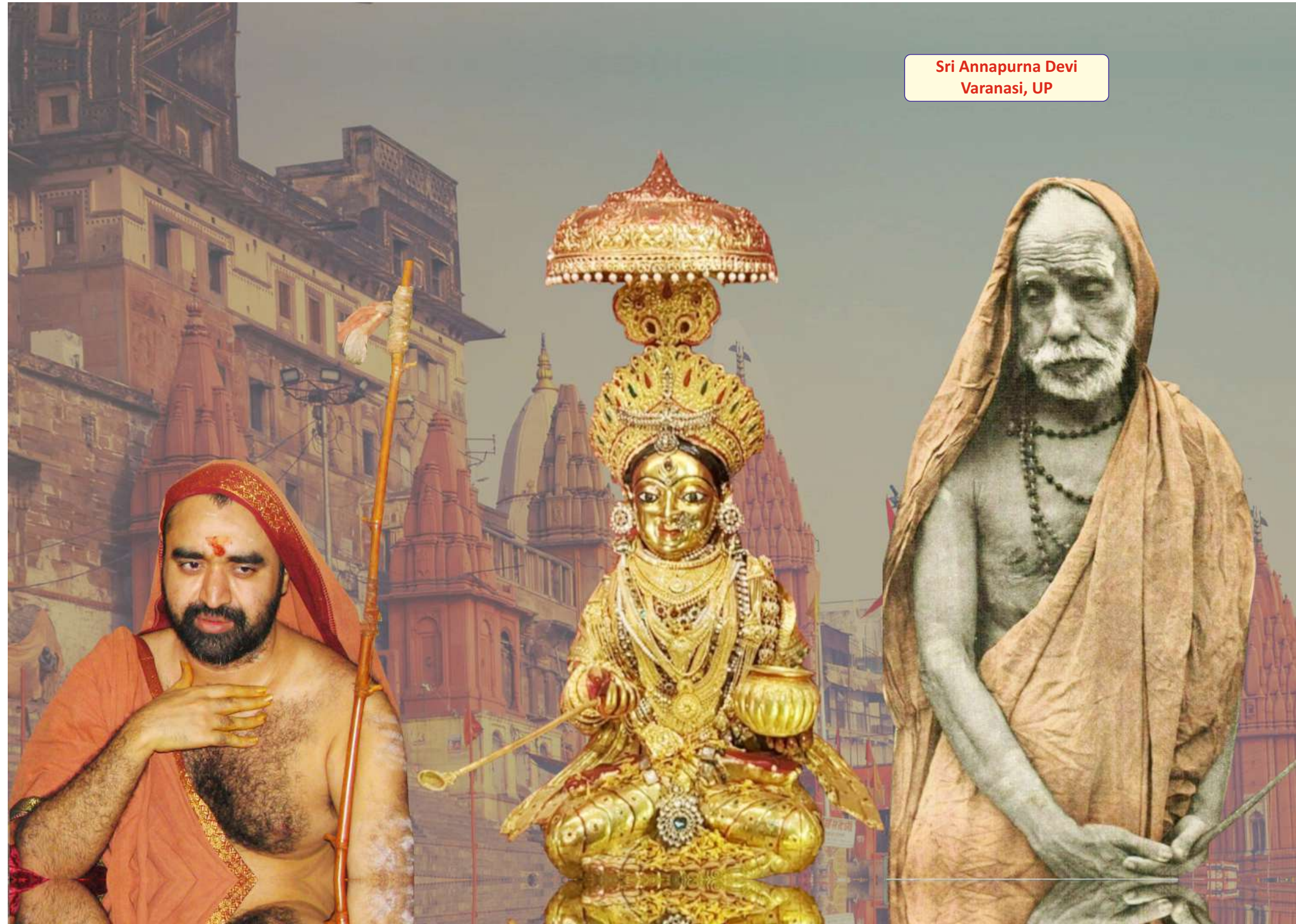
