### ❖ Sri Ram Darshan ❖

**Ayodhya Sri Ram Mandir.** Puja Sri **Maha Swamigal** dreamt of it and gave HIS blessings; Puja Sri **Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal** worked on it for many years; and in January 2024, Puja Sri Sankara **Vijayendra Saraswathi Swamigal** initiated the Yagnas and then installed the Peetam of Sri Rama with Veda Ghosham and all the traditional chanting, at the Temple in Ayodhya for a grand Vighram of Sri Ram to be consecrated (Pictures in the last page). This is one of the major contributions of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam to make the Sri Ram Mandir at Ayodhya a reality.

To commemorate the grand consecration of the Ayodhya Mandir, our Calendar of Krodhi Samvatsaram depicts various Rama Temples across Bharat. We offer our prayers to Sri Sita Devi Sametha Sri Rama with Sashtanga Namaskarams to our Gurus.

### Sri Raja Ram Temple, Orchha, Madhya Pradesh

This is a unique temple where Rama is worshipped as a King and is given a special salute each evening by the guards. The Vighram of Rama was initially to be installed in the Chatrabhuj Mandir nearby. Queen Kunwari went to Ayodhya and invoked Rama to accompany her and placed HIM at her palace in Orchha, wishing to take HIM to the Chatrabhuj Mandir next morning. Rama had however, previously told her that once He was placed down, he would not shift and so, to this day, He remains in the Palace. The Palace is the Raja Ram Temple.

### Sri Raghunath Temple, Odogoon, Odisha

This Temple, about 100km from Bhubaneshwar, has been built in the Kalinga style of architecture. Crowned with gold covered Kalasam, the Vighrams here of Rama, Sita and Lakshmana are carved out of wood. The Vighrams are dressed in the Vanavasi vesha and moustaches are visible on the faces of Rama and Lakshmana. According to legend, Rishi Atri performed his yagnas at the spot where the temple currently is.

### Sri Kodanda Ramaswamy Temple, Chikmagalur, Karnataka

On the banks of the Tungabhadra in Hiremagalur, is this temple, built in the Hoysala style. The Vighrams of Rama, Sita and Lakshmana have been sculpted from a single rock. This is the only temple where Sita is to the right of Rama, and this is due to Rama granting Parasurama darshanam in His Kalyana Kolam at the latter's request. The temple is embellished with beautiful sculptures and has a separate Sannadhi for Hanuman.

#### Sri Rama Temple, Bodhikonda hills, Ramateertham, Andra Pradesh

This Temple near Vizianagaram has an ancient history and is one of the oldest Rama temples in Andhra Pradesh. The Vighrams in the temple were installed and worshipped by the Pandavas. Brigu Rishi is believed to have consecrated the temple. Turtles with the name of Sri Vishnu can be seen in plenty here. The temple has been recently renovated.

#### Yoga Rama Temple, Nendungunam, Vandavasi, Tamil Nadu

This temple that is more than 5 centuries old has a Raja Gopuram and a Kili Gopuram. The Moolavar is a unique figure of Rama, sitting in Yoga Mudra, without his bow, listening to Hanuman seated with a Veena, chanting the Vedas. Rama is flanked by Sita and Lakshmana. The legend goes that Rama stayed here for a few days during his return to Ayodhya, at the request of Maharishi Sukabrahma.

#### Raghunath temple, Jammu

Maharaja Gulab Singh started the construction of this magnificent and grand temple and it was completed by his son Maharaj Ranbir Singh in the second half of the 19th century. The temple has seven shrines, each with its own Shikara (gopuram), which rests on raised platforms in an octagonal shape. The presiding deity is Sri Ragunath. The different forms of Surya, the Sun God depicted in this temple, is noteworthy. The temple also has numerous Shaligramams, collected by the Maharaja from the Gandaki River near Muktinath in Nepal. The inner walls of the temple are lined with gold. The Temple boasts of an excellent collection of manuscripts in Sanskrit.

#### Sri Kodanda Ramaswamy Temple, Danushkodi, Tamil Nadu

This Temple near Rameshwaram has Rama with a bow and arrow, and also has Sita, Lakshmana, Hanuman and Vibishana. This temple is the spot where Rama crowned Vibhishana as the King of Lanka, after Ravana. Vibhishana Pattabishekam is celebrated each year here, in the month of Aani. Set amidst the sea on two sides, this temple is the only structure to have survived the devastating cyclone of 1964. The ashram of Rishi Bringi is said to have been near the temple.

#### Sri Kodanda Ramaswamy Temple, Vontimitta, Andhra Pradesh

This is an elegant and impressive 16th century temple. The temple with 3 Gopurams and a Rangamantapam is adorned with sculptures. In the Garbagriha, Rama along with Sita and Lakshmana are carved out of a single rock. Hanuman has a separate Sannadhi in the Temple. The temple also has two sacred water tanks, the Rama Teertham and the Lakshmana Teertham. Sri Annamacharya composed some of his famous devotional songs in this temple.

#### Sri Rama Temple, Triprayar, Thrissur Dist, Kerala

The Vighram of Rama, that was worshipped by Lord Krishna, is the presiding deity in this Temple. Built in the traditional Kerala style, this Rama Temple is known for its ornate wood work wherein stories from the Ramayana are depicted. The Vighram of Rama here is shown carrying a chakra and a shanku. The festival on Ekadasi in the month of Vrischikam culminates in a grand procession where the Vighram of Rama is taken out on a ceremonial elephant and also by a boat on the river.

#### Kaalaram Temple, Nashik, Maharashtra

Standing on the banks of the Godavari in Panchavati in Nasik, the Kaalaram Temple was built in the 18th century by Sardar Rangarao Odhekar, who dreamt that a Vighram of Rama could be found in the Godavari. He recovered the black granite Vighrams and built the current temple over an existing wooden structure. The Garbagriha has black granite Vighrams of Rama, Sita and Lakshmana and a Vighram of Hanuman at the main entrance. The temple has 14 steps representing each year of Rama's exile. The Temple stands at the very place where Rama stayed in Panchavati.

#### Sri Rama Temple, Badrachalam, Telangana

Paluke Bangara Ramayya.... ( I am Calling you O Rama, Why do you not come ), is a famous composition by Sri Gopanna who built this Temple.... and gave a permanent grand dwelling to the Vighrams of Rama, Sita and Lakshmana that were first found buried in an ant hill. Rama is seated with Sita on his lap and Lakshmana to his left. The area around the temple were part of the Dandaka Forest where Rama, Sita and Lakshmana spent a part of their exile. Bhadrachalam is associated with Maharishi Bhadra.

#### Sri Ramaswamy Temple, Kumbakonam, Tamil Nadu

Built in the mid 16th century, this Temple is one of the three temples in India where Rama can be seen with his brothers. The vighrams here mark the coronation of Rama and He is seen seated with Sita by his side and Lakshmana, Bharatha and Shatrugna standing. Hanuman is seen holding a veenai and a manuscript, extolling the glories of Rama. The 64 pillared Mandapam narrates various episodes of the Ramayana through its friezes and sculptures.

#### Yeri Kaattha Ramar, Madurantakam, Tamil Nadu

Yeri Kaattha Ramar, literally translated as the temple to Rama who saved the lake, is a 1600 year old temple. The temple got its present name after Colonel Blaze, a District Collector of Madurantakam, had a vision of Rama, while praying for divine intervention to save the town from being deluged from the waters of the lake. Quite miraculously, the rain stopped and the town was saved and the Colonel built a Sannadhi to Janakavalli Thayyar.
